Parent Teacher Interviews—this Tuesday 31 March

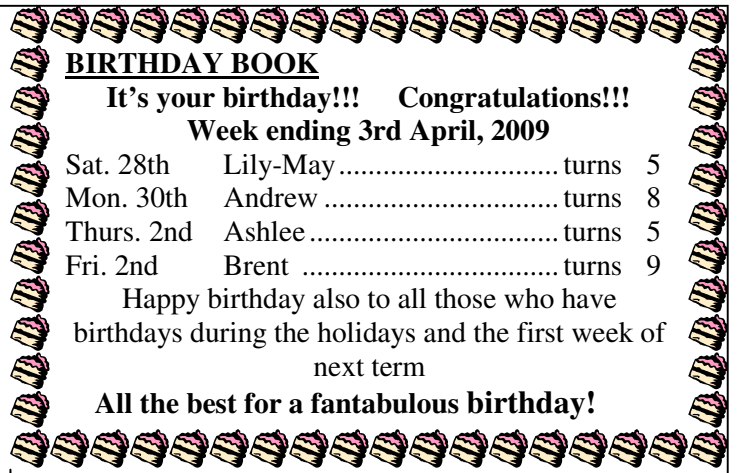

Staffing

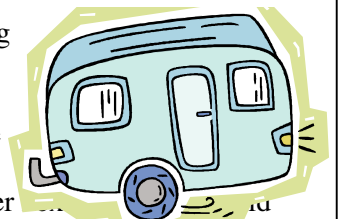
